Jia Yi is currently the Dean of Teacher Education & Undergraduate Programmes (TEUP) at NIE and has been directly involved in teacher education in NIE since 2014. He obtained his PhD in the area of Motor Control and Learning with the University of Otago, New Zealand. His research interests include examining human movement from an Ecological Dynamics perspective, developing sports expertise and in a pedagogical approach (Nonlinear Pedagogy) where key pedagogical principles underpinned by representative learning design, manipulation of task constraints, functional variability, relevant focus of attention and task simplification can support nonlinearity in learning.

He is currently on the Editorial Board for International Journal of Sport Psychology, Sports Medicine (Open), Asian Journal of Sport and Exercise Psychology, Journal of Expertise and an executive member of the Australasian Skill Acquisition Network (ASAN). For his excellence in teaching, Jia Yi was awarded the Nanyang Education Award (University, Gold Medal) and was accorded the NTU Educator of the Year in 2018. Jia Yi is currently the NTU Teaching Excellence Committee Co-Chair and a NTU Senator. He also serves as a Director to the Board of the Singapore Sports School and works closely with national sports agencies in Singapore to support sports development.
